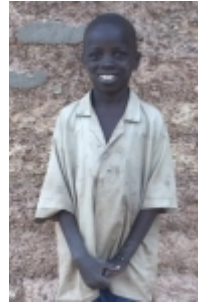

### Kayende, Daoda

Daoda was about 9 years old at the time of our visit in Dec 2008. He is in his 3rd year of school. His father died just this year in February from AIDS. There are 4 children but 1 is married and living elsewhere. Daoda and the others are still with their mother.

Daoda and his family live in a small village called Nongtaba. It is about 8 km from the town of Yako and impassable during the rainy season. Their home is a small mud brick hut in poor condition. They have no electricity, no animals, and their water source is a nearby pump.

Mom and the children work together to cultivate a field of millet to sustain themselves. There is no other work or source of income. Fortunately, the oldest is a 17 year old boy; so he is able to help care for his family. However, unfortunately, he was in school, but left it 2 years ago because he didn't have the means to continue.

All were in good health at this time.
